

Is my child ready for kindergarten?



How old does my child need to be to register for kindergarten?

Children need to be 5 years old on or before December 31 of the enrolled school year.

What are the full day and half day fees in Kindergarten?

Half Day Fees: \$160 (activity fee)

\$5 (agenda pouch fee)

Full Day Fees: \$325 per month

\$60 (lunch supervision fee)

\$5 (agenda pouch fee)

\$160 (activity fee)

Can you tell me more about snack time?

Both half and full day Kindergarten have a snack break each morning. Students are asked to pack a small, nutritious, **nut free** snack that they can open on their own, to help encourage independence. Students wash their hands before snack and eat only their own food. They do not be allowed to share snacks. Students are also asked to bring a water bottle to and from school each day.

What time does school start and end?

The school day begins at 8:30 for all students at Wild Rose. Dismissal for the morning Kindergarten is 11:20. The full day Kindergarten class is dismissed with the rest of the school at 3:10.



Tell me about the supervision available before school begins each day?

Supervisors are outside beginning at 8:15, and students enter the school when the entry bell rings at 8:30. Students enter the school at 8:30, and proceed directly to their classrooms.

Where is drop off/pick up for Kindergarten?

When children arrive at school in the morning, they will enter through the kindergarten door (door #2 on the northeast side of the school). School staff will direct students to their classroom. To encourage independence we ask parents to say goodbye at this outside area.

After school, parents wait for their children at the outside door area. Teachers dismiss students from door #2 at the end of the day.

Is before and after school care available?

Yes, there is child care available at our school provided by **SIGIS**.



Little Pearls Daycare also provides out of school care and drives students to and from our school



What is on the supply list?
